



Job Title: Camp Nurse

Position description:

Nurses are responsible for the care and supervision of all medical services. This care includes looking after ill or injured campers or staff, administering medication, communication with parents and counselors, organization of medical information, as well as keeping records of camper visits. At camp, this position will be staffed 24 hours a day.

Junior 1 Camp (Ages 8-12): June 18-22nd

Responsibilities:

- Provide First Aid for: cuts, scrapes, bruises, bee stings, dehydration and sunburn
